- What employers and industries are covered by the Ordinance
- What the Ordinance requires
 - Initial Good Faith Estimate
 - Schedules 10 days in Advance
 - Predictability Pay
 - Exceptions to Predictability Pay
- The joint responsibility of staffing agencies and their clients to comply with the Ordinance
